

MAN'S TEXTURED SWEATER

SIZE: To fit chest 95(100; 105)cm; length 67(68; 69)cm; sleeve fits 48cm; garment measures 110(115; 120)cm.

MATERIALS: PATONS BEEHIVE CHUNKY (50g balls) M 10(11; 11) balls; C1, C2, C3 and C4 2(2; 2) balls each; one pair each 6mm and 4mm Ns; cable needle; knitter's needle for seams.

ABBREVIATIONS: K - knit; p - purl; sl - slip; pssso - pass slipped stitch(es); tbl - through back of loop(s); ybk - yarn back; yfd - yarn forward; yon - yarn over needle; yrn - yarn round needle; alt - alternate; beg - begin or beginning; cont - continued; dec - decrease; inc - increase; foll - following; rem - remains or remaining; rep - repeat; patt - pattern; tog - together; st.st - stocking stitch; gst - garter stitch(es); st - stitch; Ns - needle(es); M1 - make one stitch; Cable - slip next 5sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work (k1 from left hand needle, k1 from cable needle) 5 times; Knot - knit into front, back, front and then back again of next st.

TENSION: 17.5sts to 10cm in width over st.st.

RIGHT BACK

Using 4mm Ns and M, cast on 50(50; 54)sts.

1st row: K2, * p2, k2, rep from * to end.

2nd row: P2, * k2, p2, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows 5 times, then 1st row once.

14th row: Rib 3(0; 2), * inc in each of next 2sts, rib 1, rep from * to last 5(2; 4)sts, inc in next st, rib 4(1; 3) - 79(83; 87)sts. Change to 6mm Ns.

1st row: P2(4; 6), k10, * p3, k10, rep from * to last 2(4; 6)sts, p2(4; 6).

2nd and alt rows: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear.

3rd row: As 1st row.

5th row: P2(4; 6) Cable, * p3, Cable, rep from * to last 2(4; 6)sts, p2(4; 6).

7th row: As 1st row.

8th row: As 2nd row.

Rows 1 to 8 incl form patt. Cont in patt until work measures approx 61cm from beg, ending with an 8th patt row. **

Next row: K4(1; 3), * k2tog twice, k1, rep from * to last 5(2; 4)sts, k2tog, k3(0; 2) - 50(50; 54)sts.

Work 9(11; 13) rows rib (as before), beg with a 2nd row.

*** **Shape shoulder:** Keeping rib correct, cast off 6sts at beg of next and alt rows 3 times in all, then 5(5; 6)sts at beg of foll alt rows twice. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 22(22; 24)sts loosely in

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Right Back, working 1 extra row of rib before beg shoulder shaping.

LEFT BACK

Using 4mm Ns and M, cast on 50(50; 54)sts. Work 13 rows rib as for Right Back.

14th row: Rib 5(0; 2), * inc in next st, rib 2, inc in next st, rib 1, rep from * to last 5(0; 2)sts, rib 5(0; 2) - 66(70; 74)sts. Change to 6mm Ns. Using C1, knit 1 row.

Beg 1st patt: 1st row: K1, * (k1, p1, k1) into next st, p3tog, rep from * to last st, k1.

2nd row: purl.

3rd row: K1, * p3tog, (k1, p1, k1) into next st, rep from * to last st, k1.

4th row: Purl.

Rows 1 to 4 inc form 1st patt. Cont in 1st patt until work measures approx 18.5 cm from beg, ending with a 1st or 3rd patt row.

Using C2, **Next row:** K6(0; 2), k2tog, * k2, k2tog, rep from * to last 6(0; 2)sts, k6(0; 2) - 52(52; 56)sts.

Next row: Purl.

Beg 2nd patt: 1st row: K4(4; 0), * p4, k4, rep from * to end.

2nd row: * P4, k4, rep from * to last 4(4; 0)sts, p4(4; 0).

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: As 2nd row.

5th row: P4(4; 0), * k4, p4, rep from * to end.

6th row: * K4, p4, rep from * to last 4(4; 0)sts, k4(4; 0).

7th row: As 5th row.

8th row: As 6th row.

Rows 1 to 8 incl form 2nd patt. Cont in 2nd patt until work measures approx 32.5 cm from beg, ending with a 4th or 8th patt row.

Next row: K4(5; 2), inc in next st, *k6(3; 4), inc in next st, rep from * to last 5(6; 3)sts, k5(6; 3) - 59(63; 67)sts. Using C3, purl 1 row.

Beg 3rd patt: 1st row: P3, * k1, p3, rep from * to end.

2nd row: K3, * p1, k3, rep from * to end.

3rd row: P3, * knot, p3, rep from * to end.

4th row: K3, * p4tog, k3, rep from * to end. Rows 1 to 4 incl form 3rd patt.

Cont in 3rd patt until work measures approx 46.5 cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

Using C4, **Next row:** K3(3; 7), * k2tog, k5(4; 3), rep from * to end - 51(53; 55)sts.

Work in purl fabric (beg with a knit row) until work measures same as Right Back to **, ending with a knit row.

Using M, **Next row:** Knit, dec 1(3; 1)sts evenly across row - 50(50; 54)sts.

Work 10(12; 14) rows rib (as before), beg with a 2nd row. Work as for Right Back from *** to end.

LEFT FRONT

Work as for Left Back, working 1 less row of rib before beg shoulder shaping.

Left Sleeve: Using 4mm Ns and M, cast on 46(50; 50)sts. Work 13 rows rib as for Right Back.

14th row: Rib 4(6; 6), * inc in next st, rep from * to last 3(7; 5)sts, rib 3(7; 5) - 85(87; 89)sts. Change to 6mm Ns.

1st row: P5(6; 7), k10, * p3, k10, rep from * to last 5(6; 7)sts, p5(6; 7).

2nd and alt rows: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear.

3rd row: As 1st row.

5th row: P2, M1, p3(4; 5), Cable * p3, Cable, rep from * to last 5(6; 7)sts, p3(4; 5), M1, p2.

7th row: P6(7; 8), k10, * p3, k10, rep from * to last 6(7; 8)sts, p6(7; 8).

8th row: As 2nd row.

Rows 1 to 8 incl form patt, noting that an inc was worked at each end of 5th row.

Keeping patt correct and working extra sts into purl fabric, inc (as before) at each end of foll 8th rows from previous inc until there are 97(99; 101) sts, then in foll 10th rows until there are 103(105; 107)sts.

Cont in patt until work measures 45cm from beg, working last row on wrong side. Keeping patt correct, cast off 9sts at beg of next 10 rows. Cast off rem sts.

Right Sleeve: Using 4mm Ns and M, cast on 46(50; 50)sts. Work 13 rows rib as for Right Back.

14th row: Rib 5(7; 4), * inc in each of next 2sts, rib 1, rep from * to last 5(7; 4)sts, rib 5(7; 4) - 70(74; 78)sts. Change to 6mm Ns. Using C1, knit 1 row.

Work in 1st patt as for Left Back until work measures approx 14.5cm from beg, ending with a 1st or 3rd patt row.

Using C2, **Next row:** K3(6; *2), k2tog, * k5(10; 6); k2tog, rep from * to last 2(6; 2)sts, k2(6; 2) - 60(68; 68)sts.

Next row: Purl.

Work in 2nd patt as for chest size 95cm for Left Back until work measures approx 24.5cm from beg, ending with a 4th or 8th patt row.

Next row: K2(5; 6), * inc in next st, k2(3; 2)rep from * to last 1(3; 5)sts, k1(3; 5) - 79(83; 87)sts. Using C3, purl 1 row.

Work in 3rd patt as for Left Back until work measures approx 34.5cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row. Using C4, knit 1 row, dec 6sts evenly across - 73(77; 81)sts. Work in purl fabric (beg with a knit row) until work measures 45cm from beg, ending with a knit row. Cast off 6sts at beg of next 10 rows.

Cast off rem sts.

TO MAKE UP

Using backstitch, join centre back and front seams. Join shoulder seams. Place centre of sleeves to shoulder seams and sew sleeves in position. Join side and sleeve seams.

CABLE & SQUARE SWEATER

SIZE: To fit bust 81 - 91(97 - 107)cm; length to top of shoulder 56(58)cm; sleeve seam 47(48)cm.

MATERIALS: PATONS BEEHIVE DOUBLE KNITTING (50g balls) M 5(6)balls; C1 6(7)balls; C2 2(3)balls; one pair each 3.25 and 4mm Ns; cable needle

ABBREVIATIONS: K - knit; p - purl; st - stitches; st.st - stocking stitch; patt - pattern; gst - garter stitch; M - main; C - contrast; cont - continue; beg - beginning; rep - repeat; RSF - right side facing for next row; inc - increase; dec - decrease; foll - following; alt - alternate; rem - remain/ing; NR - next row; tog - together; sl - slip; CN - cable needle.

TENSION: 10.5sts and 14 rows to 5cm over st.st using 4mm Ns.

Cable pattern: 9sts.

Row 1: K9.

Row 2 & alt rows: P9.

Row 3: Sl first 3sts on CN and leave at back of work, k next 3sts, k sts from CN, k3.

Row 5: K9.

Row 7: K3, sl next 3sts on CN and leave at front of work, k next 3sts, k sts from CN.

Row 8: P9. These 8 rows form the cable patt, repeated throughout.

FRONT AND BACK (Both alike).

With M, 3.25mm Ns, c/on 114(130)sts. Rib k1, p1 for 4cm, inc on last row as follows: inc in first st, rib 8(16), * inc in next st, rib 3, inc in next st, rib 5, * inc in next st, rib 3, inc in next st, rib a further 46 sts, rep from * to * 4 times, rib to end - 127(143)sts. Change to 4mm Ns and patt which consists of cables with reversed st.st between, and st.st squares, with gst background. Use separate balls of yarn for the squares and gst, twisting last yarn used with next to link sts. Carry yarn loosely behind work between cables, taking care not to pucker work, use a separate ball for 2nd set of cables after squares. Set as follows, working correct row of cable patt.

Row 1: K8(16) C1, (cable 9sts with M, p3sts with C1) 3 times, cable 9M, k6 C1, (k9M, 9C2) twice, k3 C1, cable 9M, p3 C1, cable 9M, k8(16) C1.

Row 2: K8(16) C1, (cable 9M, k3 C1) twice, (p9, C2, 9M) twice, k6 C1, (cable 9M, k3 C1)
